Crime Scene Search

Physical evidence can be anything from massive objects to microscopic items, generated as part of a crime and recovered at the scene or at related locations. Considering all sources of information available in investigations (e.g. confessions, testimonies, video surveillance), physical evidence plays a pivotal and an especially valuable role.

Crime scene and physical evidence awareness for non -

The CSI unit documents the crime scene in detail and collects any physical evidence. The district attorney is often present to help determine if the investigators require any search warrants to proceed and obtain those warrants from a judge. The medical examiner (if a homicide) may or may not be present to determine a preliminary cause of death.

Introduction to How Crime Scene Investigation Works -

Indoor crime scenes will be quite simply searched on a room-by-room basis, whereas outdoor crime scenes may require a more detailed search pattern. There are a number of search patterns that may be followed: Zone or quadrant search: The scene is divided into smaller, manageable portions which are searched individually.

The three physical evidence strategies are built on the foundation of Locard’s Principle of Exchange, which states that ‘every contact leaves a trace’. They are: crime scene strategy (see managing scenes) forensic strategy; pathology strategy.

Physical evidence

A crime scene is not merely the immediate area where a body is located or where an assailant concentrated his activities but can also encompass a vehicle and access/escape routes. Although there are common items which are frequently collected as evidence (fingerprints, shoeprints, or bloodstains), literally any object can be physical evidence.

Crime Scene Response Guidelines- Overview

A crime scene is any location that may be associated with a committed crime. Crime scenes contain physical evidence that is pertinent to a criminal investigation. This evidence is collected by crime scene investigators (CSIs) and law enforcement. The location of a crime scene can be the place where the crime took place or can be any area that contains evidence from the crime itself.
