Health disparities have been traced to numerous causes, including language and cultural barriers which can result in minority patients not seeking proper care for their ailments.

Is a Lack of Cultural Diversity in Healthcare Harming Our ...

Abstract A 2003 report by the Institute of Medicine identified several areas of disparity in health care due to discrimination (whether unintentional or intentional), bias, and prejudice. Given that most minority patients are treated by physicians from the majority group, the principles of cultural competency are extremely important.
