Keep in a warm place and after about six weeks, you will see roots appearing. Pot up your germinated avocado seed into a peat-free compost mix. The most popular method of sprouting a new plant from this seed is to pierce it with toothpicks. Do so about halfway down the seed, in three places evenly spaced around its circumference, and then suspend it from toothpicks with the top pointing up. Rest it on the rim of a glass which is filled with water.

Cover about an inch of the seed with water. Keep it in a warm place, but not in direct sunlight. The seed should sprout in two to six weeks. Let the young plant grow to six inches, then cut it back to three inches to encourage stronger root growth. When the new leaves have emerged again, plant the avocado in a pot with soil.

When the stem is about seven inches tall, prune your avocado plant by cutting it down to about three inches. Transfer your avocado plant to a pot filled with soil. When your avocado plant has grown new top leaves, you can plant the seed in soil. (Don't wait more than three weeks after pruning.)

These toothpicks are your avocado scaffolding, which will allow you to rest the bottom half of the avocado in water, so therefore the toothpicks need to be wedged in there firmly.
