The Education Amendment Bill presents changes in primary and secondary schools which will result in better education in the country. Amendment G seeks to change the wording of Article XIII, section 5, subsection 5 of the Constitution of Utah, which currently says, "All revenue from taxes on intangible property or from a tax on income shall be used to support the systems of public education and higher education as defined in Article X, Section 2."
