Sow the seeds at a depth of 2-3cm with about 6-8 inches apart. If you are using pots or recycled pails, you can decrease the distance between seeds. I used to plant 6-8 seeds per pot. Since the seeds are tiny, it needs to grow in a seedbox first before transplanting to its permanent pot or place. This is method is called indirect seeding. Soil in a seed box to be used in growing eggplant. In a seedbox with a potting or garden soil, sprinkle the seeds then cover with soil to about 1 / 4 inch thin.
